RTW Agreement:

Mandatory vaccinations policies for Zone A have been adopted by Magnum P.I., Murder Mystery 2 and the Blaisdell properties.

ASA & Hollywood Basic Agreements

Leading up to the ratification vote, our Local held a Town Hall meeting on Sunday, 11/7/21, where we shared historical data about the ASA and went over the terms of the new agreement. The next morning, a test email went out to members, and volunteers started to call our members to make sure they received their test emails. That Friday, November 12th, all eligible members, including new members, were sent their ballots. We sent out a text message to make sure members received their ballots. We had very few people who did not receive their ballots.

On Sunday, 11/14/21, the ratification vote for both agreements ended at 6:59PM Hawai’i Time. On Monday, 11/15/21, I received the results for our Local. Out of 625 eligible voters, 496 ballots were returned, representing 79.4% of our members who participated in the ratification. This is the first time members were able to participate in the ratification of the ASA. There were 401 YES Votes (80.8%) and 95 NO Votes (19.2%). The results for the were announced by President Matthew Loeb.

Both agreements were ratified, and a press release from the International as well as our results were sent out to all members.

VIRTUAL TRAINING: Oahu Film Commissioner Walea Constantinau contacted about a complaint someone had made recently about filming at night. Previous complaints made about night filming were largely made by neighbors who didn't like the bright lights shining into their homes, but this time it was a complaint made due to it being Shearwater Fledgling Season. Like monk seals and sea turtles, shearwater fledglings are federally-protected in Hawai'i. Walea was concerned because there was a resolution going through the City Council which could affect exterior location filming. Because Hawai'i is primarily an exterior film location, the IATSE has the most crew on set, and control the lights, we decided to accept this as our kuleana and scheduled a virtual meeting to discuss and educate all that attended.

On Saturday, October 30, 2021, AT 9AM, Local 665 hosted an Educational Industry Discussion via Zoom. After a brief introduction by myself and Walea Constantinau, Trisha Kehaulani Watson (Honua Consulting) gave a detailed presentation of what the acceptable and unacceptable actions are when working outdoors. It was attended by two (2) presenters, 41 members, three (3) non-members, and four (4) guests (mostly Locations). In my invitation, I mentioned that members would be paid a training stipend of \$100, subject to the approval by the membership. [The request for this training stipend was approved by the GMM].

SHOWS IN THE QUEUE:

Salt Spring Media/Endeavor Content (ASA) – “Ka’iana”

Streaming TV show. Last we heard, they were getting their contract together. No new info.

Warner Brothers “Corinthian”

No new information.

SHOWS PREPPING:

SeaGlass Productions – “Murder Mystery 2” – Feature

They have hired lots of construction crew and are now interviewing set crew.

Redemption Pictures, Inc./Warner Brothers – “Aquaman 2/Necrus” – Feature

They are shooting for one week on Oahu. This feature stars local film actor, Jason Momoa.

They are filming in the UK and bringing most of their crew and hiring a few Local 665 crew.

SHOWS ACTIVELY SHOOTING:

CBS - Eye Productions – “Magnum P.I.” - Season 4:

Nothing new to report. They are still breaking for one-hour lunches which is not a contract violation.

CBS – Eye Productions – “NCIS – Hawai’i” – Season 1:

Nothing new to report. I will say that the UPM and Production Supervisor called me to let me know they would not be on the lot if we were to go on strike. They were in support of the ASA strike.

SHOWS THAT HAVE WRAPPED:

Warner Brothers/Bumper Productions – “Ke Nui Road” – Pilot for a Series

This show wrapped on November 2nd. Their payroll was a nightmare, and several crew members either didn't get their onboarding link or didn't get paid. The UPM Robert Scott said that it was due to the payroll company, Cast and Crew. For the record, Cast and Crew has had lots of payroll problems, including consistently not withholding work dues. I am working with UPM Robert Scott to figure out how to expedite payment to the crew.

NON-UNION SHOWS:

Sight and Sound Productions, now owned by Bryan Spicer, did two films so far that were too low to sign on as IA shows.

GRIEVANCES

Maui – Yale Productions or Yale Pictures “Paradise City”- The International is auditing this show to see if they exceeded their estimated Low Budget threshold of \$7.5M. No new info to report.

Maui – Tradewind Productions “Temptation Island – S3”

86 crew members who were affected by the grievance have all been paid.

TRADE SHOW & CONVENTION –

HSLR hired about 20 of our Local 665 workers for a Salesforce event out at Four Seasons Ko Olina. It was extremely hot, and several workers became ill due to heat exhaustion.

Encore (formerly known as PSAV) has a new district manager, Michael Marovich, who lives on Maui and is committed to using IA members. They introduced me to their Kaua'i and Hawai'i Island Encore team.

OUTSTANDING PAYROLL

- Payment for the three technicians is still ongoing.
- As reported earlier, I am working with Ke Nui Road UPM Robert Scott to get the crew paid.

Hawai'i Teamsters 996 had an election, and they have a new President. The former President, Wayne Ka'ulu'la'au has decided to run for State House of Representative for District 25.

Organizing and Political Activism

The Area Standards Agreement has been ratified. Many thanks to the volunteers who staffed the phone banks over the course of the last week to promote participation. Local 665 had nearly 80% of eligible members participate in the vote. Of that, nearly 81% of eligible 665 members voted in favor of ratification while 19% voted in opposition. While the ASA has been ratified, it's only the beginning. We must hold employers, and each other, accountable to these new contractual stipulations. Start your work at call time, not before. Mark your meal penalties with precision. If you don't take NDBs, don't put them on your time card. We believe we've built a strong firewall to deter the employer from committing abuses. But firewalls aren't 100% effective. We need to stay vigilant and monitor the effect of this new agreement.

There is a tentative agreement with MagicSpace Entertainment that will be voted on for ratification at the November 2021 GMM.

Training and Development -

Now that professionally managed Live Events have been greenlit for the City and County of Honolulu, it's more important than ever to build up our skills and certifications. OSHA 10-GES classes are available through the IATSE TTF. We may also hold OSHA 10-GES classes for our members through our certified trainers, but it will take the commitment of attending members to show up for these classes in advance. Also, if more than 10 members are interested in a certain type of training, and can commit to attending, we'll put in an application to the IATSE TTF for course reimbursement. Course reimbursement applications for the second quarter of 2022 are due before March 4th 2022. For more information, visit latsetrainingtrust.org
